**Intervention support Y2 and Y6** - A higher % of PP children were on target to reach age related expectations or above in all subjects at KS1 And KS2 in 2020  
**Speech and language service level agreement** - this targeted support contributed to diminished differences between pupil premium and non-pupil premium children in 2019 and was continued this academic year  
**School counsellor** - one-to-one support provided for social/emotional issues This helped to improve pupil well-being and ensured pupils were better able to access learning  
**Relax Kids** - Children were taught skills of becoming resilient, capable, self-assured and confident in their abilities. Children were taught to manage their feelings, and to develop positive relationships and social skills
